

Notice to Mariners No 04/25

ARDERSIER PORT REDEVELOPMENT

Continued removal of Old Quay wall piling and Diving Operations

Mariners are reminded that Ardersier Port is being redeveloped into an Energy Transition Port and remains closed to commercial and leisure traffic until the works are completed in the latter part of 2025.

Large scale Quay works are planned, updated Notices to Mariners will be published as works progress.

Following construction of a new Quay wall, built ashore and behind the original Quayside, the 1970's original Quay wall and sheet piling is being removed as the next stage of this project.

Diving works will be conducted in the vicinity of the hard stop.

Statom group have engaged TMS Maritime (Teignmouth Maritime Services) as Diving contractors.

Diving operations will be conducted between January through to July 2025, 24 hours a day.

The diving operations will be conducted off a jack-up barge.

All vessels are to navigate with extreme caution when in the vicinity of Ardersier Port and to proceed at minimum speed to maintain steerage way, keeping a good lookout.
