

Notice to Mariners No 07/25

ARDERSIER PORT REDEVELOPMENT Deployment of CAB TELEBUOYS

Mariners are reminded that Ardersier Port is being redeveloped into an Energy Transition Facility and remains closed to commercial and leisure traffic until the construction works are completed later in 2025.

Major Dredging operations are planned and updated Notices to Mariners will be published as these works progress.

As a part of the consenting process two CAB telebuoys will be deployed for approximately four months in the following positions, from 25th March 2025 until the required channel depths are achieved. The buoys are part of a joint project with the University of St. Andrews.

Positions:

Burghead

57deg 42.984' N

003deg 31.803'W

Riff Bank

57deg 36,784' N

004deg 01.080'W



Both buoys, pictured above, will be lit with Fl. W. 5s. 1m lights. They can be identified by the word CAB printed on them and a Yellow Saint Andrews X top mark.

Mariners are asked to keep clear of these environmental research telebuoys, which will be monitored by Ardersier Port.
