ARDERSIER PORT REDEVELOPMENT

Whiteness Sands – Spreader Pontoon

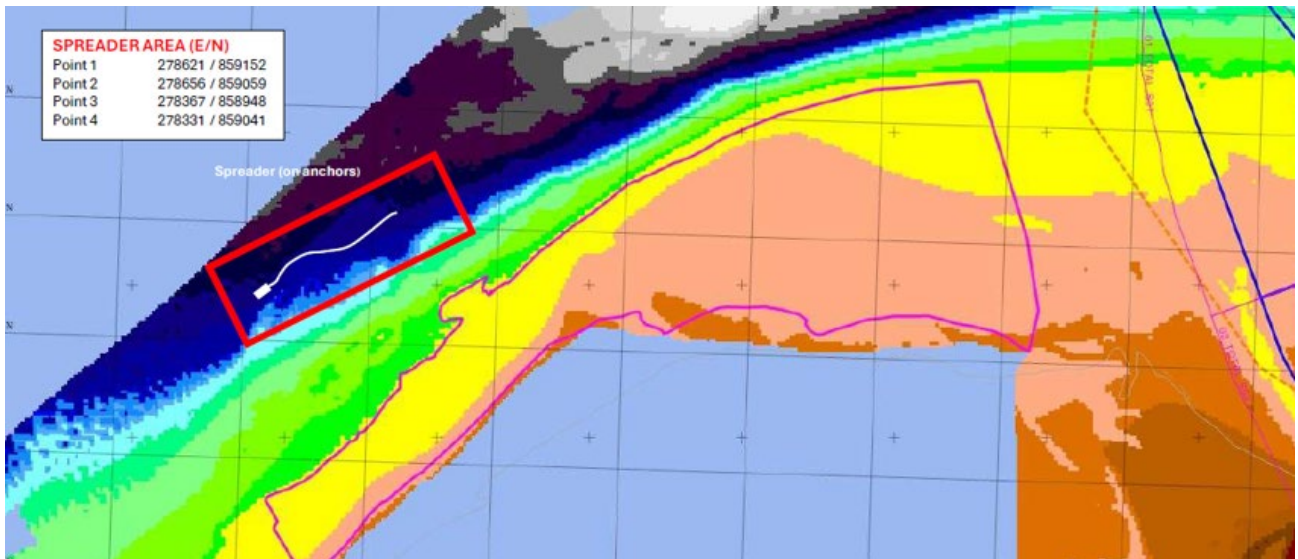
Mariners are reminded that Ardersier Port is being redeveloped into an Energy Transition Facility and remains closed to commercial and leisure traffic until the construction works are completed later in 2025.

A spreader pontoon with rubber floating lines, with total length of 207m (excl. anchors) has been deployed in the Whiteness sands area.

The spreader is held in position by 2 anchors, each marked by yellow pennant buoy and white connection buoy (connection to the spreader/floating line) and fitted with 3 white flashing lights (start / middle / end) on 1m steel poles.
